INFORMATION ON THE HUGH HOPPER BENEFIT CD, *THE GIFT OF PURPOSE* FROM NICK DIDKOVSKY



I got a message a few months ago from **Hugh Hopper's** wife Christine. She reported that since Hugh's passing, she's been struggling with finances. Of course she's also struggling emotionally, as she misses him terribly, but the gist of her message was a call for financial help.

She recalled that Hugh told her that if she ran into trouble, to ask their friends for help. So she did. In response, **John Roulat**, **Steve Feigenbaum**, and I decided to produce a limited edition benefit CD, *The Gift Of Purpose*. The CD features a live concert by **Bone** (Didkovsky/Hopper/Roulat) that was beautifully recorded at **Orion Sound** in Baltimore. There is also a bonus track by myself, John, **Colin Marston** (**Behold....the Arctopus**, **Dysrhythmia**, **Krallice**), and **Daavid Allen** (**Gong**, **Soft Machine**, etc). Daavid contributed some very moving vocals which pay tribute to Hugh.

John, Steve, and I are splitting the manufacturing costs and donating the gross income to Christine. Steve has already wired her some money in advance. *The Gift of Purpose* is a **Cuneiform** release, in digipak format, with cover design by **Bill Ellsworth**. So it looks and sounds very, very good!

For those of you new to Bone, we were a trio that was initiated when Hugh contacted me some years ago suggesting we collaborate on a record. Our record ***USES WRIST GRAB*** came out on Cuneiform a few years back, and we figured we were done. However, we were sort of drafted into doing live performance by **Bruce Gallanter** of Downtown Music Gallery, who invited us to perform at a festival he'd organized. Once we discovered we could pull off this material live, we did a handful of gigs, including the one on this record. We're very proud of the performance we unleashed in Baltimore, and thrilled that we can make it available to all of Hugh's friends through this benefit CD!

There's **ONLY** going to be 500 of these. We are severely limiting radio and review copies, so please do not request one. If you want to play it on your radio show or write about it, please buy one and support Hugh's family directly!

Formed in 1984, the instrumental group Djam Karet has just released their 15th CD titled "The Heavy Soul Sessions". Recorded Live-In-Studio

without any overdubs or computer manipulation, this 65 minute CD features six tracks that showcase the band at its fiery best.

Recently the band performed a few of their rare live shows, which included music from throughout their long career. This included a few gigs in Los Angeles, and also France where they headlined a 3-day progressive rock concert called The Crescendo Festival. When they got back, they decided to play their tunes again, this time recording them in their own private studio, in order to better capture the group's wailing and aggressive live sound. And so the CD "The Heavy Soul Sessions" was born.



Also, a side-group they have called Ukab Maerd has just released their new debut CD "The Waiting Room", filled with 64 minutes of analog and modular synths, electric guitar, and mangled nightmares. This Electronic music group was created by Chuck Oken, jr and Gayle Ellett, and features French Electronic music pioneer Richard Pinhas performing computer-altered guitar loops on 3 of the 4 tracks. Doctor Nerve emerged from the recording studio a few weeks ago, having finished tracking five new tunes! This is the first recorded material that welcomes Ben Herrington to the band (Ben is perhaps best known for his magnificent trombone playing in Meridian Arts Ensemble). We're very excited by the music that's gone down "to tape" and look forward to mixing it soon!

Nick and John Roulat (Bone) are beyond proud that the Hugh Hopper benefit CD "The Gift of Purpose" will be out any second now on Cuneiform Records. This CD features 40 minutes of a Bone concert, beautifully recorded at Orion Sound in Baltimore, adding a 15 minute bonus track where Nick and John are joined by Daevid Allen on vocals, Yves Duboin on soprano sax (Doctor Nerve), and Colin Marston on Warr Guitar (Behold! The Arctopus, Dysrhythmia, Krallice, etc)

FAR CORNER

Far Corner conducted a recording session on Friday the 13th (of August). The date, with its magical or perhaps "bad luck" significance, allowed the group to perform a healthy amount of wrong notes to better transform the tightly composed music into darker creations, now infected by of all kinds of ugly distortions of sound. The session saw the completion of all percussion tracks for album number three, with keys, cello, and bass nearing the end of their recording journey for the album.

Bassist William Kopecky was busy recording tracks for the Flyin' Ryan Brothers the same week he recorded for Far Corner. William and Craig, both a part of the dark ambient trio Yeti Rain, finished work mixing their next album.

Dan Maske traveled to the state of Georgia in March to perform with the Globe Saxophone Quartet on drumset for his composition "Wind and Weaponry." The group performed at Western Georgia University and the

University of Georgia, in Athens, for the North American Saxophone Alliance Convention.

Cellist Angela Schmidt has been using her talents to perform and record with The Julie B Well, a progressive rock quintet from Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Besides his involvement with Far Corner and Yeti Rain, percussionist Craig Walkner has been performing regularly with Justin Black, an artist based in Austin Texas.

Review of Gary Lucas' June 5th solo acoustic concert at McCabe's in Santa Monica
by Roy Trakin in HITS Magazine 6/11/10

Gary Lucas at McCabe's Guitar Shop, Santa Monica: The best damn blues-rock-avant-garde guitarist you probably never heard of, Gary Lucas was a CBS Records copywriter when I first met him in the late '70s (he coined the Clash ad line, "The only band that matters") before heeding the call of musicianship. The co-lead guitarist in his idol Captain Beefheart's band from 1980-'82 for his Virgin albums, *Doc at the Radar Station* and *Ice Cream for Crow*, the Yale grad submitted music to the late Jeff Buckley, who put the

words to the songs which eventually became "Grace" and "Mojo Pin," before joining Lucas' Gods and Monsters as lead singer. Since then, Lucas has become an in-demand performer who frequently travels around the world—he recently returned from the Transylvania Film Festival, where he played along to a Spanish version of the original silent movie *Dracula*—and has collaborated with everyone from Leonard Bernstein to Lou Reed, Chris Cornell, Alan Vega, Iggy Pop, Dr. John, Patti Smith, Bob Neuwirth, Adrian Sherwood, Richard Barone, Peter Stampfel, DJ Spooky, Allen Ginsberg, John Zorn, Bryan Ferry and John Sebastian. He also co-wrote several songs with Joan Osborne, including the Grammy-nominated "Spider Web" from her best-selling *Relish* album. An infrequent visitor to L.A., nothing could be better than seeing a master craftsman like Lucas surrounded by guitars of all shapes and sizes hanging on the walls, silently vibrating with the sounds coming from the stage. With his ever-present floppy hat, Lucas' pick-less lightning-quick, percussive fingering style harks back to the old Delta bluesman as it anticipates the multi-layered post-modern sensibility, as he simultaneously creates overlapping leads and rhythm. The set offers an overview of his career, starting with "Hurly Burly," his own attempt at a traditional blues stomper, then into "Let's Go Swimming," a tribute to the late, idiosyncratic downtown avant-disco composer Arthur Russell. A medley of "Mojo Pin" and "Grace" is followed by a lovely rendition of Alberto Iglesias' score to the Spanish film *Sex and Lucia*, a lilting affair that shows the breadth of his cinematic stylings. Lucas melds several Chinese pop songs from the fertile Shanghai film studios of the '30s, which he first recorded for the compilation *The Edge of Heaven*, recently re-released by Knitting Factory Records, remarkable for marking the overlap of east and west culture. He also previews instrumental versions of Rolling Stones songs "The Last Time" and "She's a Rainbow," from an upcoming album he's working on with Andrew Loog Oldham. Grammy MusiCares' Scott Goldman joins Gary for a pair of duets on his own compositions, "10 Foot Rule" and "Bipolar Express," whimsical cross-sections of their two styles that form a synchronous call-and-response like matching pieces of an intricately configured puzzle. The highlight, though, is Lucas' version of his old pal Don's "Sure Nuf and Yes I Do," the first track on Beefheart's *Safe as Milk*, expressing his love, admiration and interpretation of Van Vliet's genius. By the time Gary's finished and greeting his quorum of dedicated admirers back in the storefront—including highbrow types like *L.A. Times* TV critic Robert Lloyd, music journo Richard Cromelin and *This Is Your Brain on Music* author Daniel J. Levitin—it is clear we have all witnessed one of the world's most innovative, unique axemen in peak form. You owe it to yourself to do the same.
